Pursuit Sailing

All boats are welcome to come and join some light hearted pursuit sailing around Eastbourne and Pevensey Bay. Pursuit sailing is a fun way to enjoy a day out on the water and sailing against other boats but without the busy start lines and short legs of traditional racing. It is great fun for boats who just want to go out and have a nice sail in company and something different to your usual sail around the bay.

How it works

- Each boat gets its own start time. This means there is no busy start line like in traditional racing, because boats start at different times according to how fast the boat is.
- Slowest boats start first.
- Fastest boats start last, and try to catch up with the slower boats in front while enjoying a nice sail.
- The pursuit finishes after 2 hours is up. Everyone wins because sailing is fun. The order the boats are in when the reach the next buoy after 2 hours is up, is their finishing position, so you just need to make a note of the boat in front and boat behind and we'll work it all out afterwards over a cup of tea.

When is it?

There will be one pursuit per day on the Saturday and Sunday of the August bank holiday weekend **Where is it?**

Sovereign Harbour Yacht Club in Eastbourne are hosting the event this time around.

What will the course be?

The course will feature long legs allowing boats to settle down and enjoy the sailing, and a total target duration of around 2 hours. You are of course welcome to carry on having a nice sail if you wish.

Do I need a spinnaker?

No, but you are welcome to fly one if you would like to. You will just need to decide before the pursuit so this can be factored into your allocated starting time. You will get given a head start for not flying a spinnaker.

What about the other regatta fleets?

We will be aiming to keep the pursuit fleet away from the other racing fleets

How will I know when to start?

You will be allocated a start time before the pursuit sail, and you can call us on Channel 77 if you want to check. Start times will be using 11:00am as the average to base boat's individual start times around. **Is there a fee?**

The pursuits are £10 per day, which goes towards the costs of putting on the event.

Is there anything else I need to know?
